## OT Tip of the Month

Wrapping and unwrapping presents can be tricky, but they don't have to be!

Have you heard of The Little Elf Wrapping Paper Cutter? Slide it down a roll of wrapping paper for a quick and smooth cut. This tool makes the frustration of keeping a roll of paper in place while managing scissors a thing of the past!



For a more accessible unwrapping option, tuck a ribbon under the wrapping paper! Start by taping one end of the ribbon to the gift, then wrap the ribbon once around the gift, finishing with a loop of ribbon that pokes out of the wrapped gift. With a pull of the ribbon loop, the paper will tear to reveal your special gift.
