
Aubrey Spencer

OT Tip of the Month

Looking for a fun craft idea this summer?

Check out this <u>"Crayola Menorah"</u> created by Esther O. It helps stabilize marker caps and allows for better grip on the marker itself. Not to mention, it helps keep the workspace organized!

- Begin by locating a sturdy container/organizer for the base.
- Mix Plaster of Paris using disposable container and spoon
- Pour mixture into container/organizer and insert marker caps into Plaster of Paris (should be ¾ of the way covered)
- Arrange in any way you like!
- Allow plaster to fully dry before placing markers in caps

How To Set Up A H2L Fundraiser


